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CATARACT SURGERY PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

For the 2 days before surgery, use the following medications in the _____ eye:



ZYMAXID: 1 drop **2** times a day.



ACUVAIL: 1 drop **2** times a day,
using one vial per day.

***Please also put 1 drop of each medication in the operative eye the morning of surgery.**

(When taking these drops please space them 5 minutes apart)



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CATARACT SURGERY POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Starting as soon as you get home, use the following medications in the _____ eye:



ZYMAXID: 1 drop 2 times a day until the bottle runs out.



ACUVAIL: 1 drop 2 times a day, using one vial per day, until all the vials are finished.



DUREZOL: 1 drop 3 times a day for 1 week, then 1 drop 2 times a day until the bottle runs out.

****Please fill this prescription at the pharmacy.**

- Take the above eye drops in any order, but please space them 5 minutes apart.
- Resume your regular medications and regular diet.
- Take Tylenol if you have any discomfort.
- Call our office **immediately** for any severe pain, redness, or sudden decrease in vision.
- Do not rub your eye.
- Do not bend at the waist or lift heavy objects for the first 2 days.
- You may shower or wash your hair, but keep soap and water out of your eye.
- You may use supplied sunglasses if necessary.
- Tape the eyeshield over your eye while sleeping for the first two nights.
